Dear Seacliff Manor Resident/Families:

The health and safety of our residents, and our team members who serve you, is our highest priority. All retirement homes are responsible for ensuring that residents' needs are met safely. Seacliff Manor ensures you that the measures we have taken thus far, were purely made with our best intentions at heart. We are finally making progress and the new directive set out on June 9, 2021 proves that we are heading in the proper direction.

Visitation will now be permitted in resident rooms, visitation stations 1, 2, or 3, as well as outdoors. Visitors must wear their PPE (mask) at all times, continue physical distancing of 6 feet, and schedule your arrival time with reception. Screenings will continue as per usual. There will be no limit to the number of visitors, nor a limit of how long you can stay. Visiting hours will remain from 8:00am – 8:00pm.

Testing and screening of all staff will continue. Documentation of screening will also continue.

Absences will be permitted overnight for non-medical purposes. Please see the General Manager for clarity as extensive leaves may have quarantine guidelines.
